

Q. What is fat grafting and can it help add volume to my face?

A. "Volume loss to the cheeks and under the eyes is part of the aging process, and fat grafting can rejuvenate the face with natural-looking results. Fat grafting is a surgical procedure that requires general anesthetic and is much more elaborate than using a dermal filler. Fat, usually taken from the thighs or stomach, is harvested and then transferred into the recipient site. You can expect soreness and bruising for up to two weeks in the donor and recipient areas, but if you want a long-lasting effect using a natural substance, are willing to undergo a procedure, or have a history of reaction to fillers then you may be a good candidate for fat grafting."

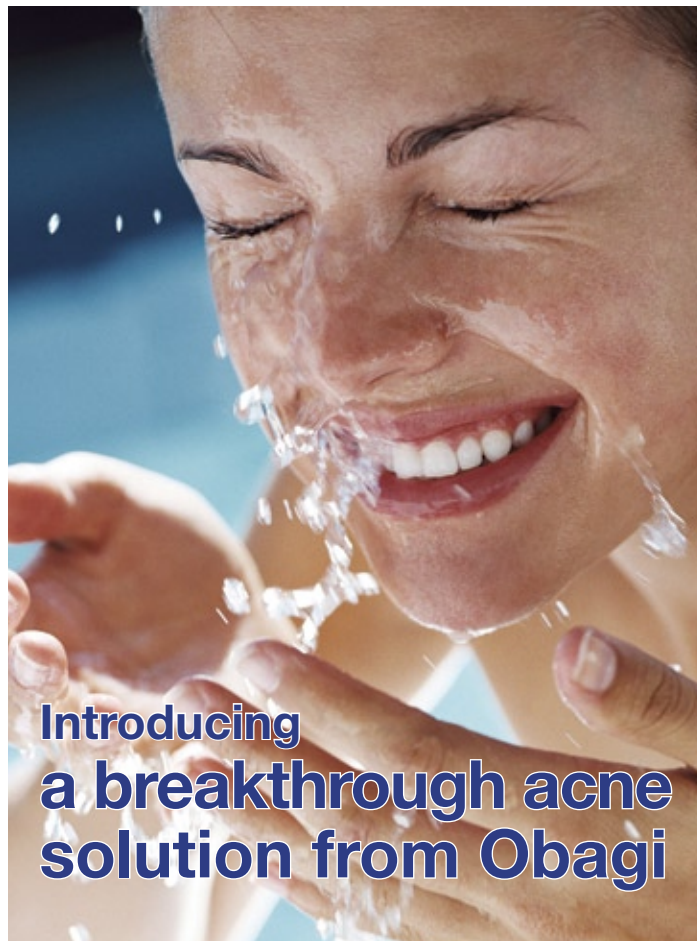
